3 LONG-RUN PERIODS (AGES) from the INDUSTRIAL REVOLUTION

THERE HAS BEEN ARELATIVE DECLINE of THE US' POSITION. COMPARED to CHINA & OTHER PARTS of ASIA.

THE CURRENT RISE of ASIA MIRRORS the RISE of the WEST in the 19th CENTURY, EXCEPT it has DRIVEN DOWN GLOBAL INEQUALITY

BUT as CHINA CONTINUES IMPORTANT than INEQUALITY

to GROW, it will TURN from an ENGINE of EQUALITY into a CONTRIBUTOR to GLOBAL INEQUALITY.


